SMCCA BOARD NEWS

The SMCCA Board met at Sugarloaf in early August and finalized plans for the hallway upgrades. The work will begin this fall and is set to be completed by ski season. Carpet will be replaced with a modern barn board pattern, designed by Shaw for Birchwood Interiors, working together with Boyne Design and the hotel staff. It will be custom made and the design will be unique to the Sugarloaf Mountain Hotel.

Hallway walls will be stripped of the current wallpaper and replaced with solid colors. There will be one color above the chair rails and one below. The current oak chair rails and baseboards will be left in place and stained a darker color. Guestroom doors will be painted a new color to complement the new design. Hallway sconces will be replaced and fitted with Edison style bulbs. New lights will be installed in hallway ceilings to brighten the hallways.

Walls opposite of elevators on floors 3, 4 and 5 will be covered with fireproof barn board and a few design elements will be placed in front of the walls. Artwork will be added to the hallway, and the design and placement of art will be determined upon further review.

Improvements will be made to the entryway near the hot tub on the 2nd floor to provide a more appealing and welcoming look for guests entering the hotel.

Painting/staining, light carpentry, and replacement of light fixtures will be completed by our maintenance staff to help keep costs down. The entire project will be funded from our reserve accounts and no special assessment will be needed.

Other items: The window replacement project for this year will begin in late September. The design plan and placement of new room furniture is still in planning. Our goal is to have the ideal finished product so we are moving gradually.
